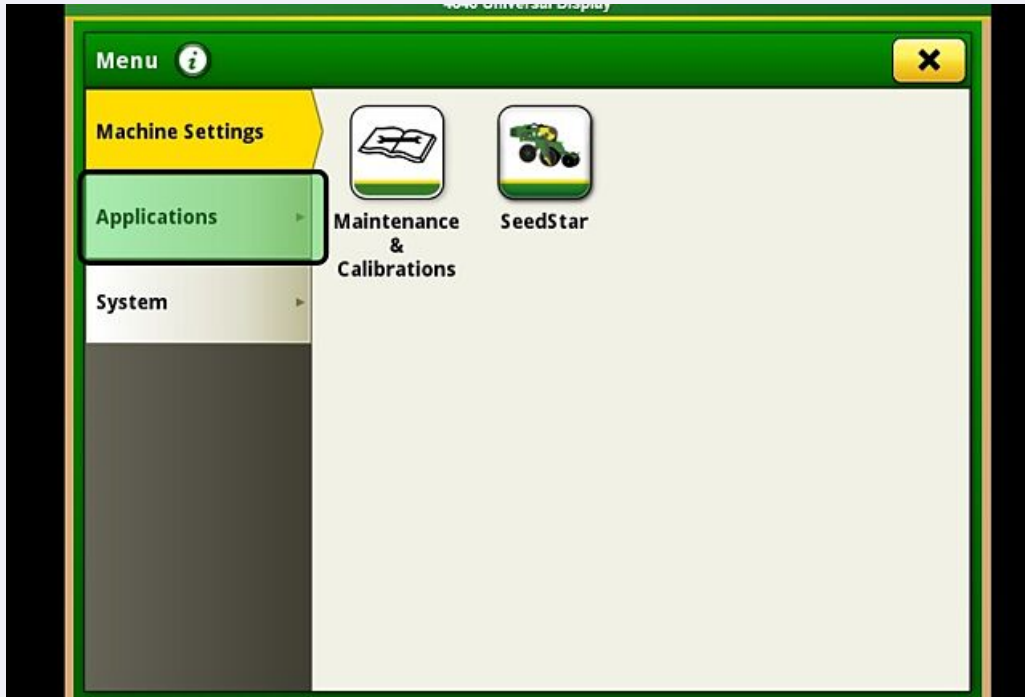
Gen4 - Creating Boundary from Coverage

How to make a boundary from coverage on a Gen4. This process can be used after an operator has done one FULL pass around the entire field.

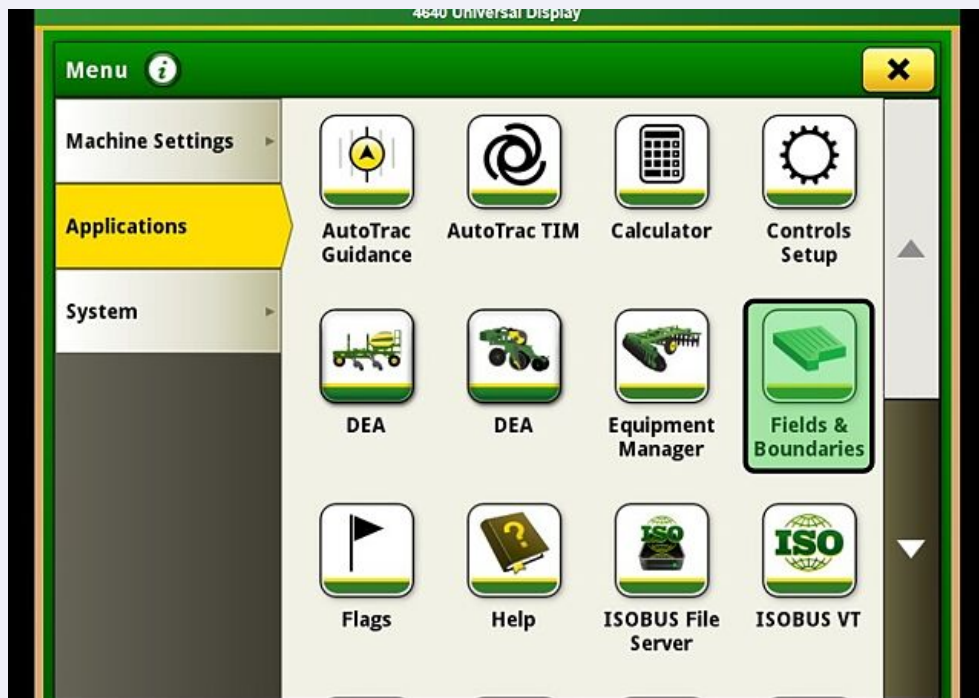
1 Select Menu



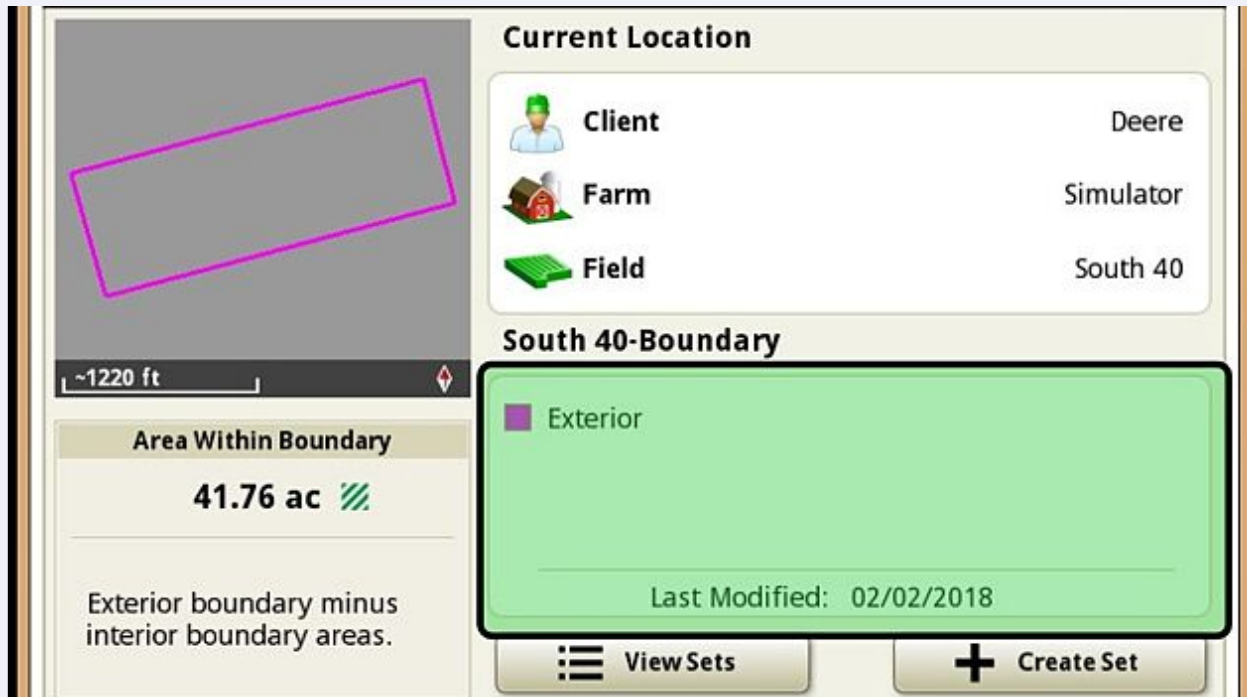
2 Select Applications



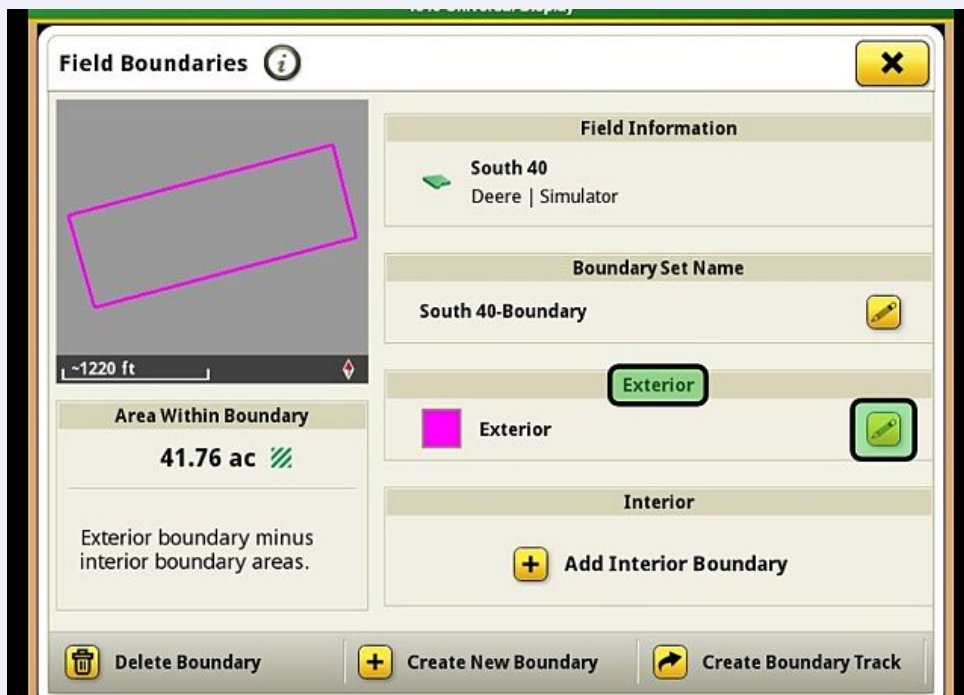
3 Select Fields and Boundaries



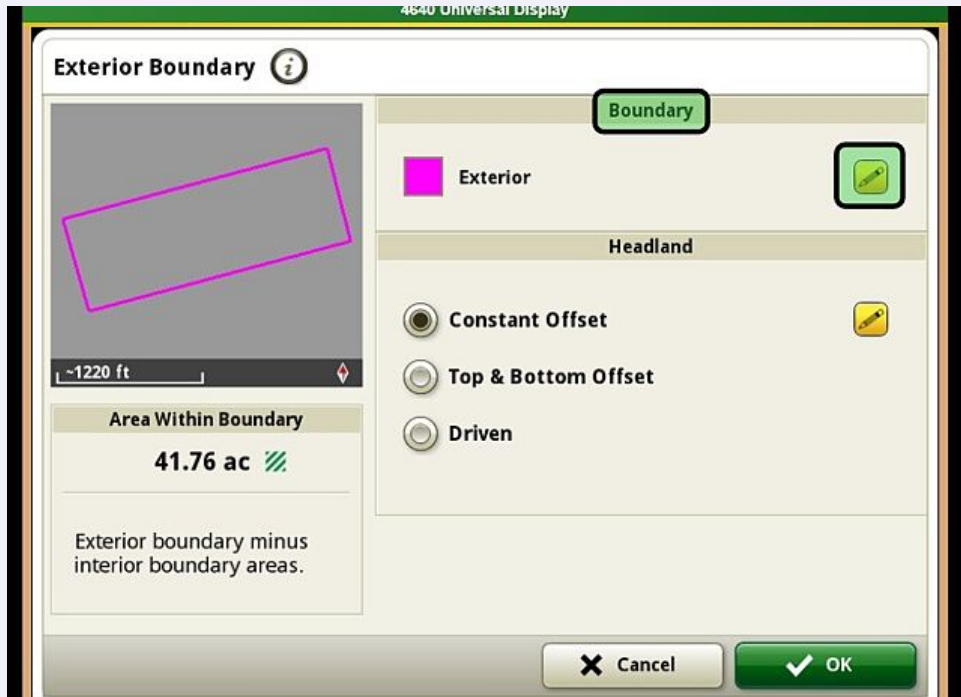
- 4 Select the white box under Field Name - Boundary



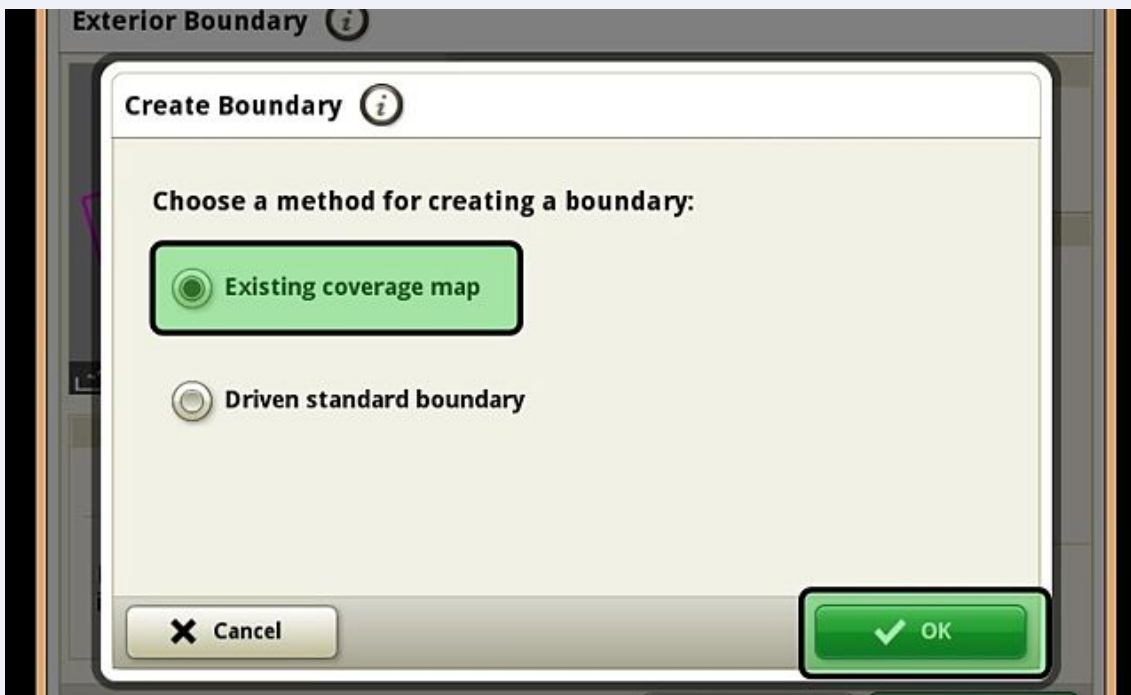
- 5 Select the Pencil underneath the Exterior Category



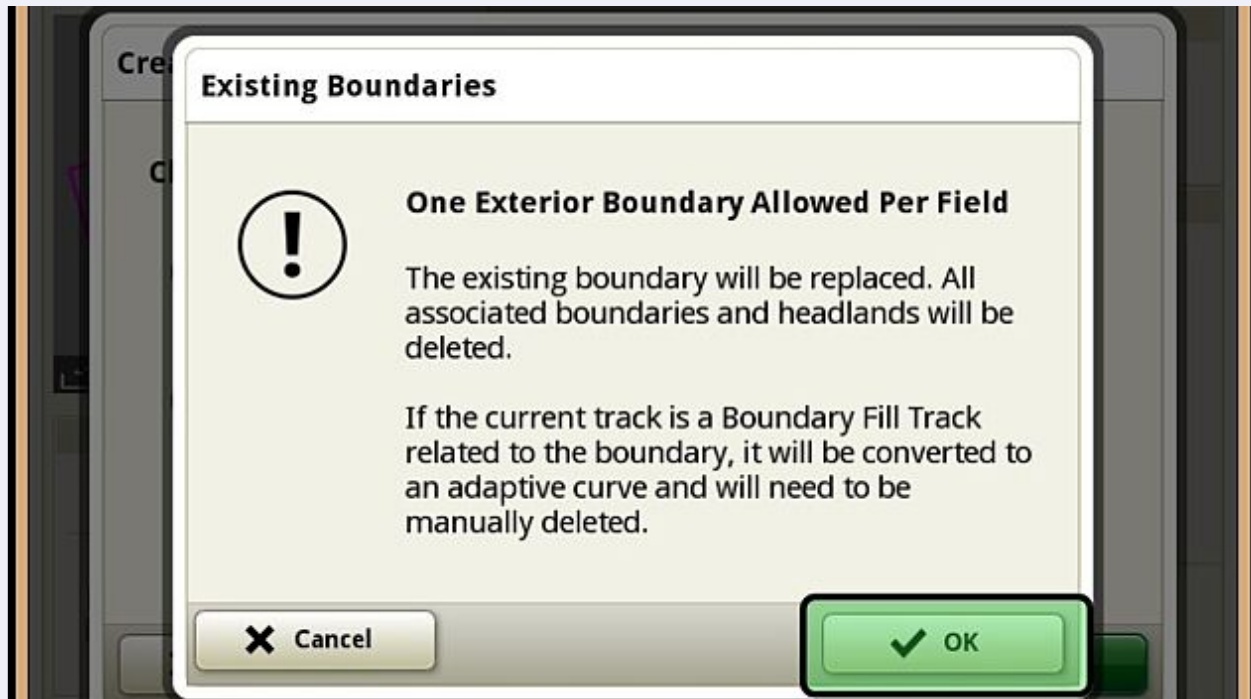
- 6 Select the Pencil under the Boundary category



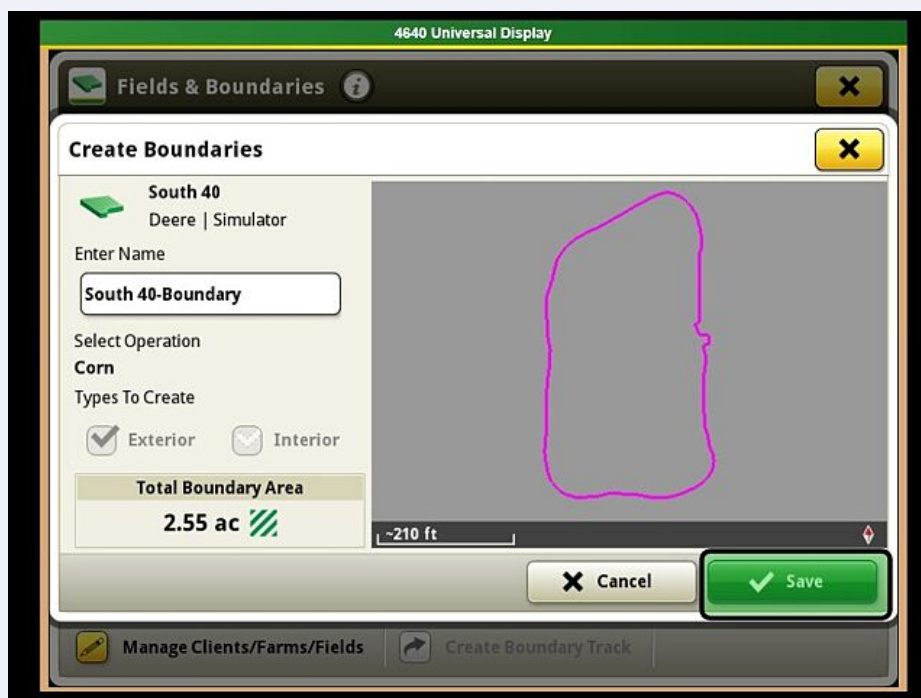
- 7 Select Existing coverage map and then select OK



- 8 Read the warning regarding the existing boundaries and then select OK



- 9 Verify your boundary looks correct and select Save. Recommended to be specific on the name of the boundary. Include things like Accuracy level, year, and season. Ex. 2023 Spring SF-RTK

Once boundary has been saved, Operator can X out to their original run pages and use options like Boundary Track, add Headland Boundaries for Headland control, etc.
