




Gen4 - Creating Boundary from Coverage


How to make a boundary from coverage on a Gen4. This process can be used after an operator has done one FULL pass around the entire field.




2 Select Applications




Select Fields and Boundaries




4 Select the white box under Field Name - Boundary




Select the Pencil underneath the Exterior Category




Select the Pencil under the Boundary category




Select Existing coverage map and then select OK



8 Read the warning regarding the existing boundaries and then select OK



Verify your boundary looks correct and select Save. Recommended to be specific on the name of the boundary. Include things like Accuracy level, year, and season. Ex. 2023 Spring SF-RTK



Once boundary has been saved, Operator can X out to their original run pages and use options like Boundary Track, add Headland Boundaries for Headland control, etc.
