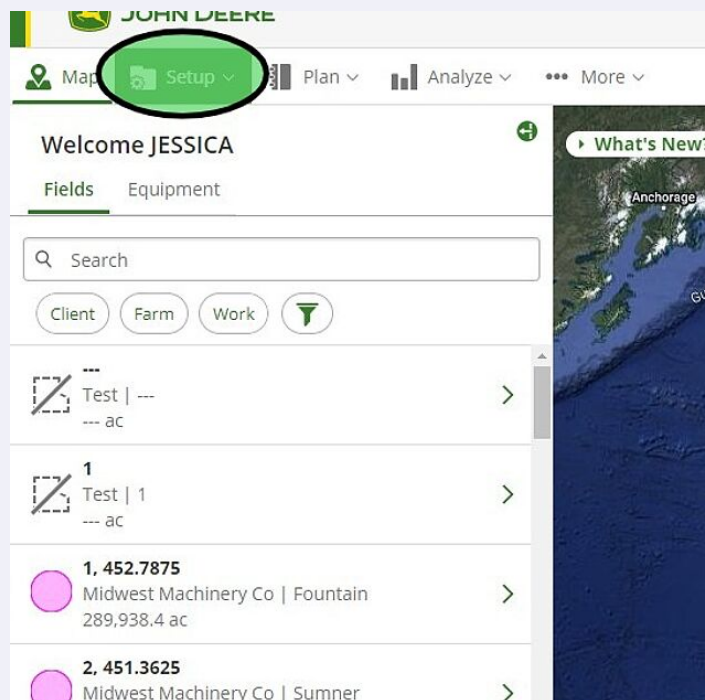

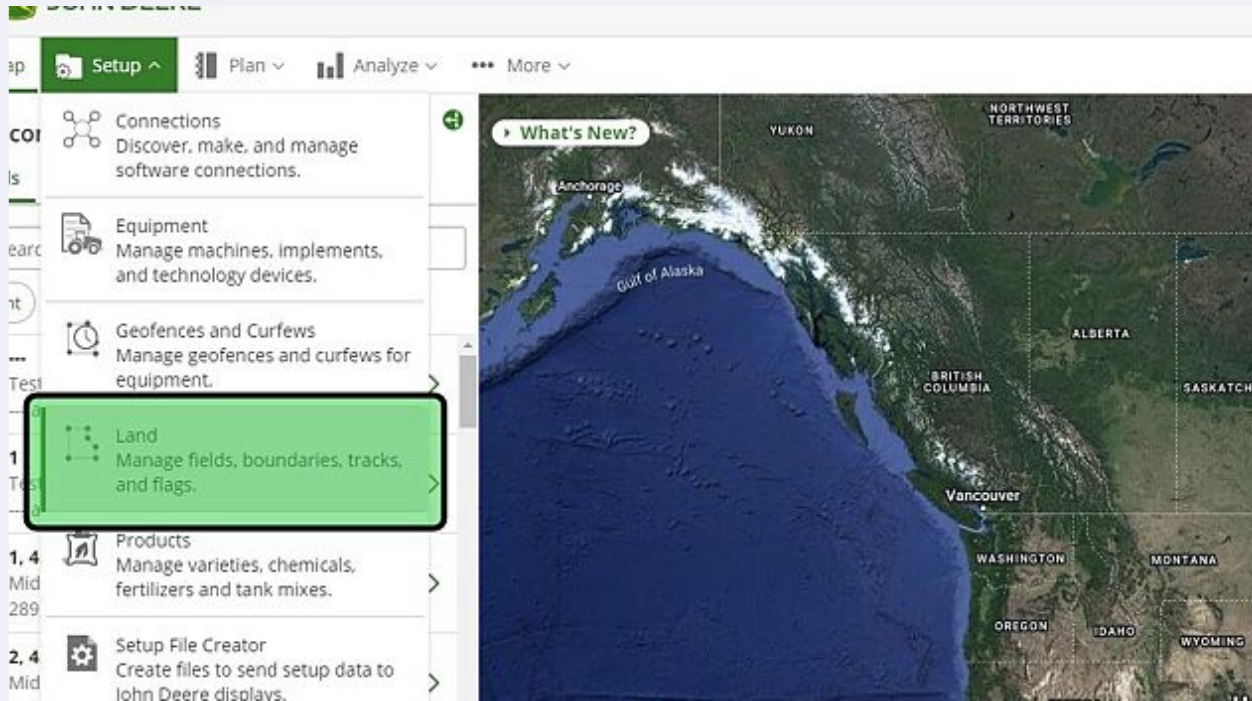
How to rename Clients, Farms, and Fields in Operations Center

2 Select "Setup"

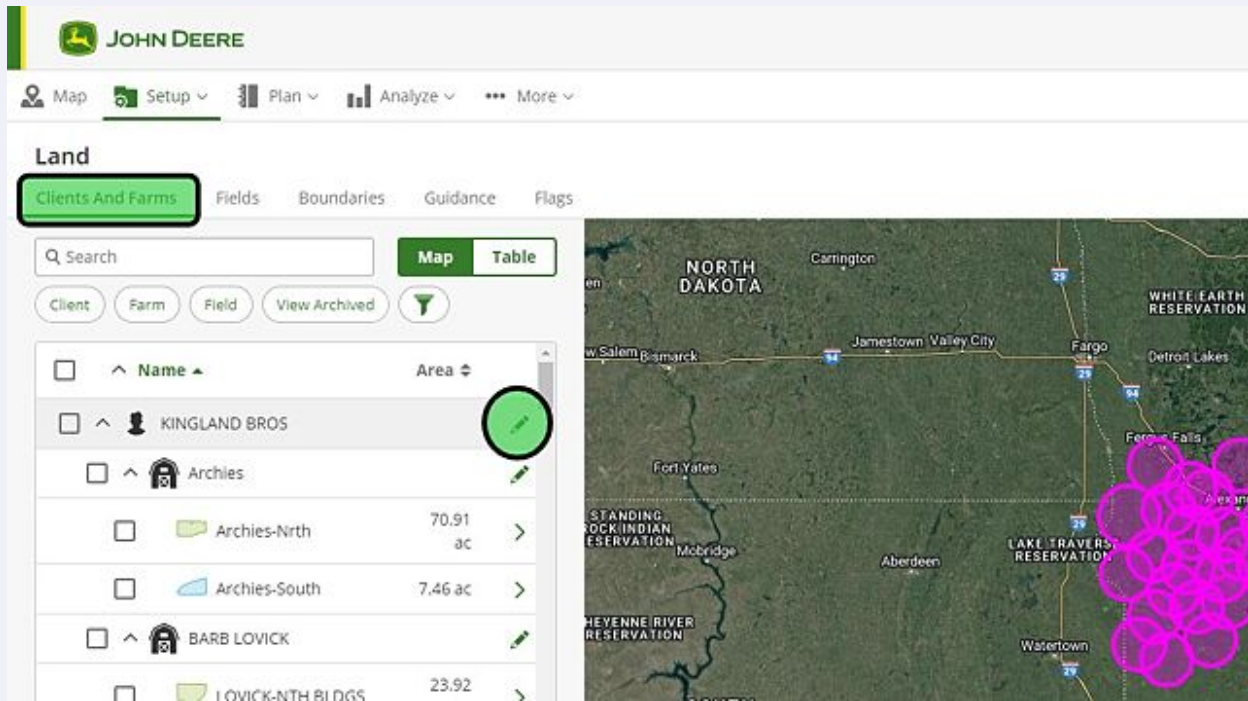


### 3 Select "Land"

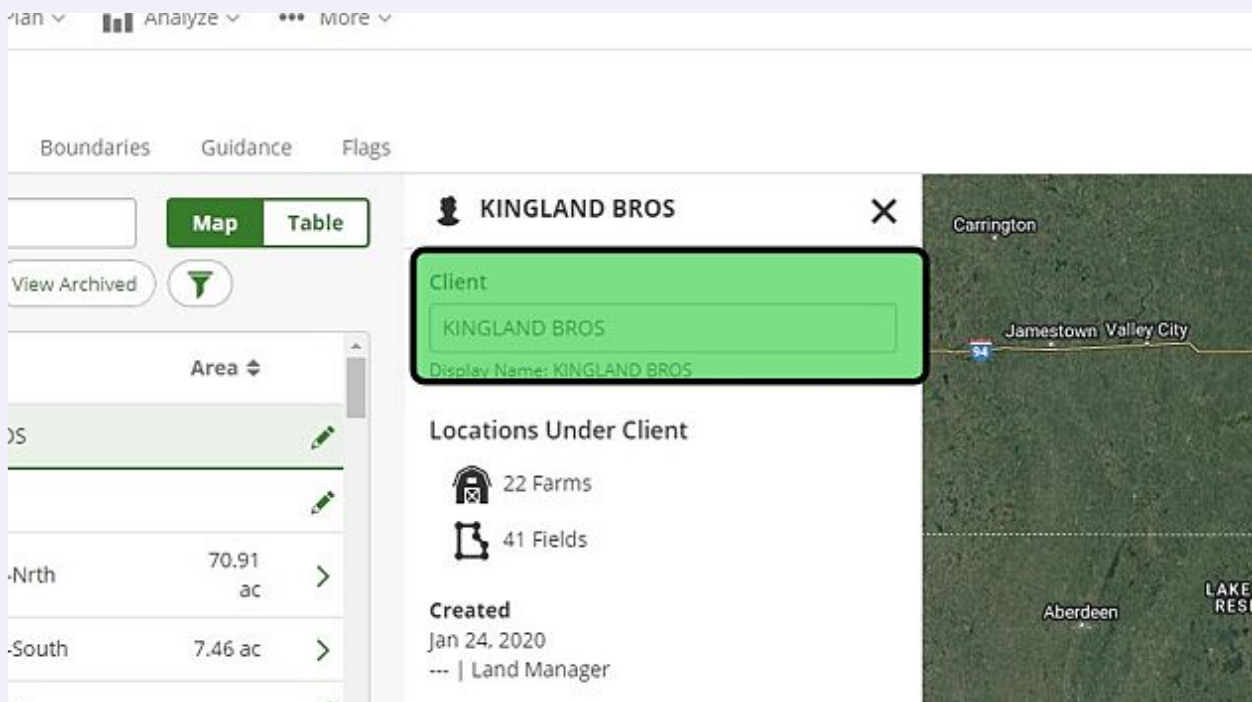


## Editing a Client

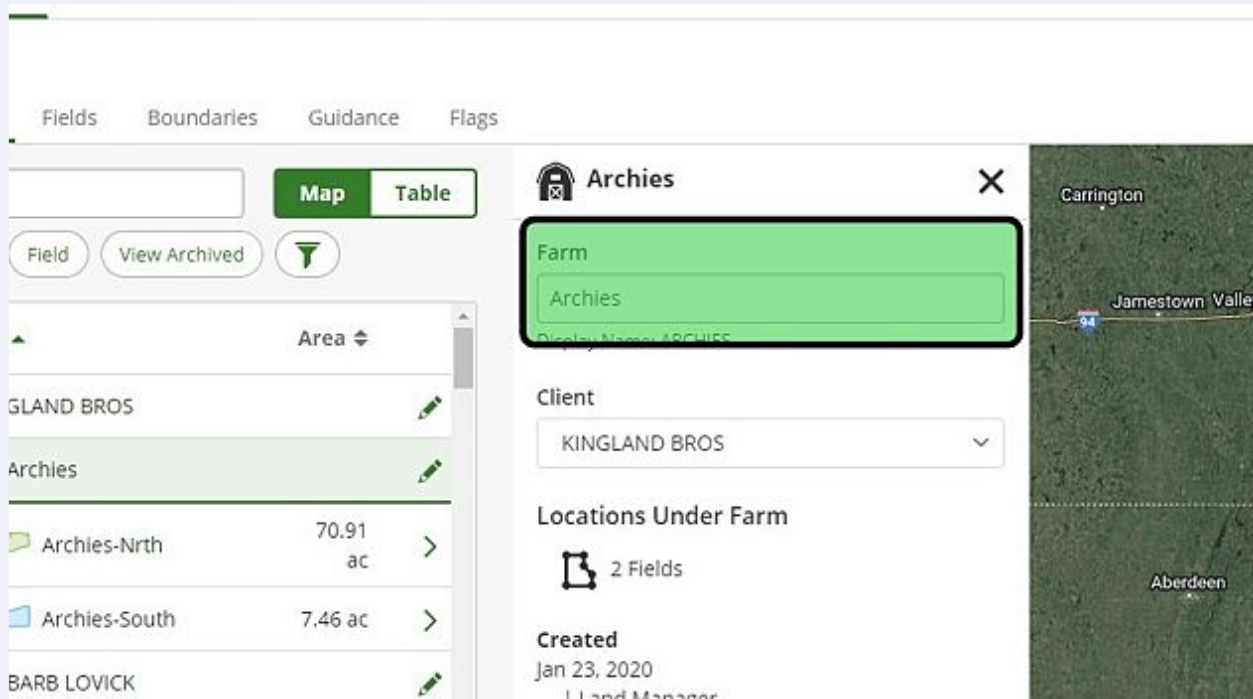
Find the Farm to edit and select the pencil next to it. Farms have a depiction of a barn next to them. Verify that user is under the "Clients and Farms" menu.

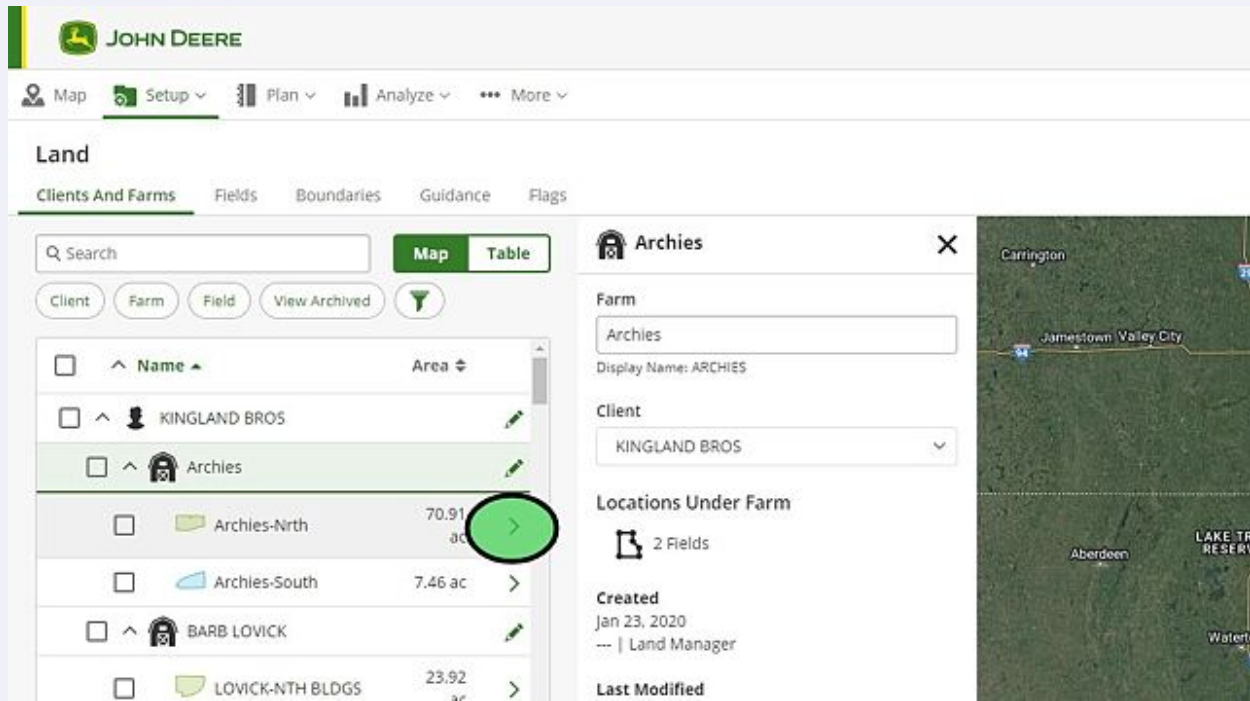

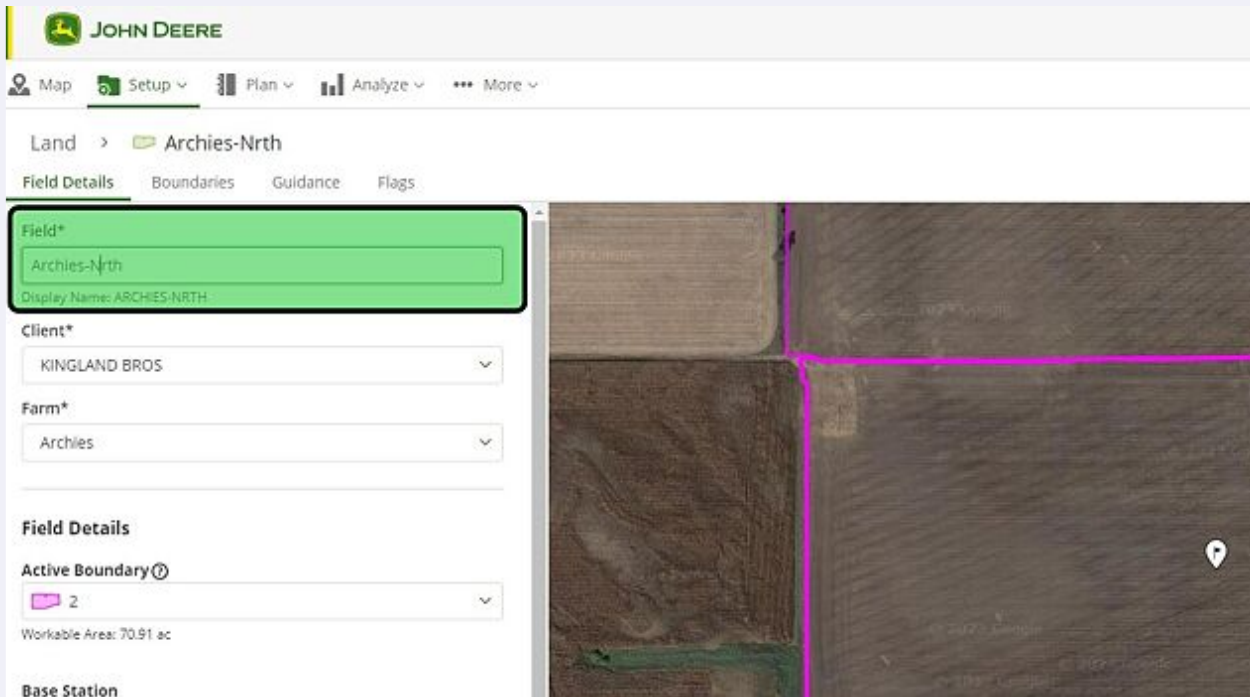
